## PERSONAL EXPERIENCE

We had the privilege to visit Kipepeo on site for 10 days in October 2022. During this time we were able to visit different families and the street boys together with the Kipepeo staff and listen to their stories. The work of Kipepeo is incredibly diverse. Each family is empowered according to their resources and abilities. So we have seen all kinds of support. From the woman who received a pig as start-up capital, to a family supported with a rice field, to children whose school fees are covered by Kipepeo, to name just a few examples. What impressed us the most is that the support provided by Kipepeo brings real changes to the families and improves their living situation. Most of the families have been able to maintain the business that Kipepeo has enabled them to do for several years, generating a steady income in the long term. The gratitude of the people supported by Kipepeo touched us deeply. Everywhere we went, people were incredibly happy to see Kipepeo employees.

### *Volunteering:*

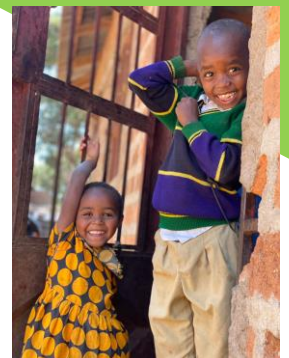
