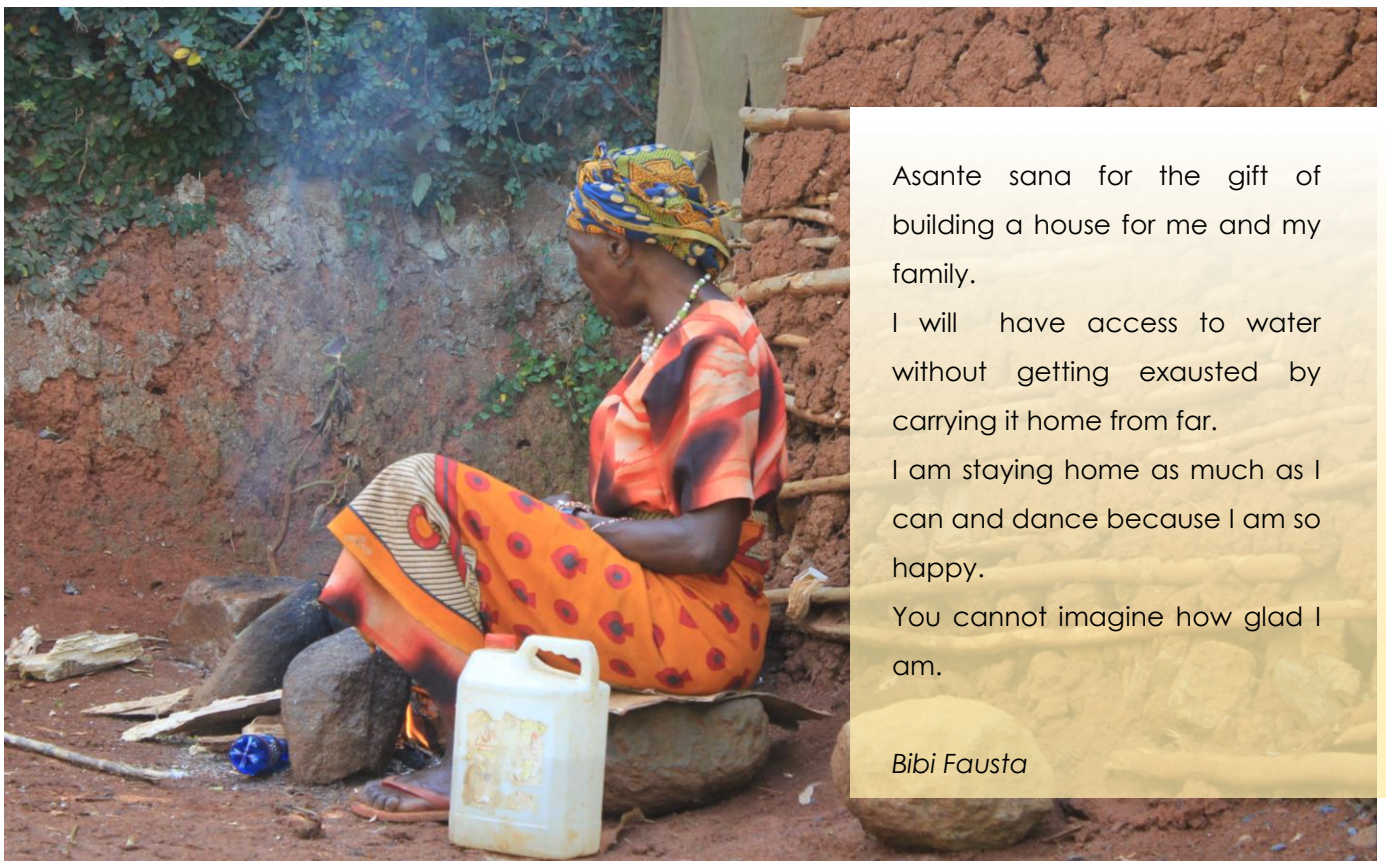

### BUILDINGS

Safety is a basic need and if there is no house or home then that need can't be fulfilled. Children must grow up in a safe and healthy environment. By that reason we did:

- ♥ Finished the house of a widow and her two girls and built a toilet next to it.
- ♥ Renovated the only room of Saidi's home, where he lives with his alcohol addicted wife and their both children in order to not get homeless.
- ♥ Built a house for Fausta, who has been released from prison, in order to live with her two girls and care for her Aids-sick Mother.

## EDUCATION

Nineteen children got school-uniforms, school items such as dictionary, books, pencils and we payed a year of the School-fees untill their parents could take over the costs.

Rehema, Hassani, Emmanuel and Ayubu were sent to boarding schools. For those four we took over the responsibility of educating them untill they graduate from school. The parents task is to provide pocket money while they are in school, pay health care for them if needed, visit and provide a home for them while holidays. The reason why those children are at boarding schools is, that they were living in an abusive community where they had no perspective for their future. They all lived in conditions in which it was impossible to stay. In order to grow out of it, having a better future they need to get educated and hopefully, on this way they can still have contact to their families

## HELP FOR THE MASAI

Depending on the location and environment in which the supported families are living there are diffent solutions we provide. This year we were among other communities also working together with the Masai. They have their very own way to live and their culture is as unucque as every new tribe we get involve with. In the Masai land and culture is self-supplying very common. Kipepeo mostly provided goats. According to their tradition can a goat:

- ♥ provide milk and meat to a family
- ♥ be increased to a whole cattle from which they are able to use an animal in case of an emmergency
- ♥ when they need urgent money o
- ♥ used for business reason by selling their milk or a goat itself

There are many ways using a goat which is always profitable for a Masai family.

## SUSTAINABILITY

Steps toward an inependent future of Kipepeo Family Foundation were made.

- ♥ Provided a motorcycle to a father with a payback-system that does not harm him but strengtens him in his self responsibility and provides us automatically with finances again to support a new member.
- ♥ Our Hostel Kiwavi Home is running still, even after the long corona season. Thanks to everyone who visited this place and helped on this way to contribute!
- ♥ We have the finances to buy farmland on which we can have a self sustainability project holding animals to provide for future families and harvest vegetables for closeby communities.
